Call for Applications

Applications are invited from Senior Academic Staff members (Senior Lecturer Grade II or above) of the University for the above post.

The Director of CECCS will be responsible for overseeing the operations of the Centre under the guidance of the Management Committee and the University Council. The Director will function as the administrative and accounting officer of the Centre, ensuring the effective management of resources and compliance with relevant financial regulations. In addition, the Director will act as the primary liaison with the Senate, the Finance Committee, and other relevant University bodies, seeking guidance and approvals where necessary.

The Director will be appointed by the University Council from among the Senior Academic staff of the University who have demonstrated experience in climate change-related teaching, research, and knowledge dissemination, in accordance with the By-Law governing CECCS.

The appointment will be for a period of three (03) years. The selected candidate will also be required to perform teaching duties in line with their academic role, in addition to directing the Centre.

Interested candidates are requested to submit a self-prepared application, together with an updated Curriculum Vitae and a three-year development and sustainability plan for the Centre, addressed to the Vice Chancellor through the proper channel on or before **30.03.2026**.
