Ceylon Petroleum Storage Terminals Limited (CPSTL) invites applications from suitably qualified and experienced persons for the post of **Project Manager** for contract administration of Kolonnawa to Harbour Pipeline Project (KHPP), a major EPCC cross-country and offshore petroleum pipeline development implemented under a FIDIC Silver Book contract framework.

Qualifications required.

- BSc Engineering degree (Mechanical) from a recognized university.
- Minimum 15 years of post-qualification experience in large-scale engineering on onshore and offshore petroleum pipeline projects.
- Strong knowledge and practical use of FIDIC Silver Book or similar EPC/EPCC contract conditions, and familiarity with relevant pipeline design and construction standards (ASME, API, ASTM, etc.).
- Demonstrated competence in project planning and control using Primavera P6 (preferred) or MS Project, including S-curves and critical path scheduling.
- Sound understanding of HSE and QA/QC management systems applicable to petroleum pipeline projects.
- Excellent communication, negotiation and report-writing skills in English, with proven ability to lead multi-disciplinary teams and manage diverse stakeholders.

Added qualifications

- Corporate/Chartered Engineer status (e.g. CEng, IESL or equivalent)
 - Project Management Professional (PMP) from PMI or an equivalent recognized project management certification
 - Postgraduate degree in Project Management, Pipeline Engineering, or Offshore Engineering.
- **Possessing Project related qualifications/experience would be a definite advantage.**

Duties & Responsibilities

- Provide overall leadership and management of the KHPP EPCC contract from commencement to final completion and handover, ensuring full compliance with the Contract, Employer's Requirements and applicable laws/standards.
- Act as the central point of coordination and main interface between CPSTL, the Contractor, Engineer/Employer's Representative and all external stakeholders including Sri Lanka Ports Authority, Sri Lanka Railways, utilities and regulatory agencies.
- Review and recommend acceptance/adjustment of the Contractor's Baseline Schedule (Primavera P6), monitor progress, identify and implement mitigation strategies to address potential delays, and support Extension of Time (EOT) assessments based on critical path analysis.
- Arrange and lead/represent CPSTL at progress and review meetings, ensuring clear documentation and follow-up of decisions, risks and action items.
- Coordinate technical reviews of designs, method statements and construction methodologies for both onshore and offshore segments, working closely with CPSTL design, project and discipline engineers.
- Support contract administration under FIDIC Silver Book, including variations, claims, contractual correspondence, employer risk management, compliance verification, achievement of contractual milestones and the preparation of submissions to the DAAB where required.
- Oversee implementation of quality and HSE management systems, ensure compliance with CPSTL and statutory requirements, and maintain a project Risk Register with appropriate mitigation actions.
- Plan and coordinate inspection, testing, pre-commissioning, commissioning and handover activities; ensure timely completion of punch lists and project documentation including as-built drawings, data books and O&M manuals.
- Prepare/coordinate internal and external project progress reports, including time, cost, HSE and risk status, and provide leadership and mentoring to the CPSTL project team.

Service Conditions

- The appointment will be on contract basis for a period of fourteen (14) months subject to renewal on the project requirement and successful performance.
- Maximum age limit for the above post is 65 years as at the closing date of application.

The Company will contribute 15% of the salary towards the EPF whilst the employee will have to contribute 10% for the same. The Company will also contribute 3% of the salary towards the ETF. Selected candidate will be placed on probation for a period of three years from the date of assumption of duties.
