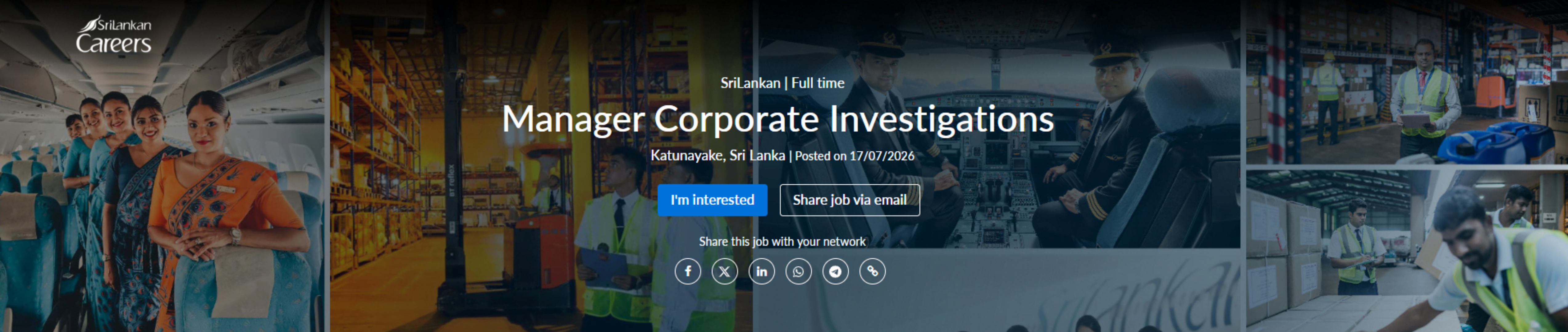

Purpose:

Report on investigation outcomes, verification performance, and compliance risks to senior management to support strategic decision-making.
- Lead, mentor, and manage the Investigations and Document Checkers teams, setting clear performance expectations, identifying development needs, and building a high-performing, professional, and motivated workforce.
- Collaborate with divisional heads to align investigation activities with organizational objectives and policies. Responsible the annual budget for Safety and Service Trainings, ensuring adequate manpower and equipment while accounting for business continuity plans and future company requirements.
