AND

OR

- A Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) or Master of Education (M.Ed.) degree from a university recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC), along with teaching experience as a Tamil Language teacher.

- A PhD, MPhil, MA, or Bachelor of Laws (LLB) (Honours - First Class/Second Class Upper Division) degree from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC).
