Salary Scales:

- a) Senior Lecturer Grade I - Rs. 160,520 - 7 X 3,900 - 187,820 p.m. [U-AC 3(I)], will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 160,520/- p.m., Academic Allowance of 116 % + Rs. 2,200/- of salary will be paid
- b) Senior Lecturer Grade II - Rs. 138,980 - 11 X 2,940 - 171,320 p.m. [U-AC 3(II)], will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 138,980/- p.m.; Academic Allowance of 116 % + Rs. 2,100/- of salary will be paid
- c) Lecturer (Unconfirmed) - Rs. 121,340 - 5 X 2,940 - 136,040 p.m. [U-AC 3(III)] , will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 121,340/- p.m., Academic Allowance of 102 % + Rs. 1,800/- of salary will be paid
- d) Lecturer (Probationary) - Rs. 94,400 - 10 X 2,400 - 118,400 p.m. [U-AC 3(IV)], will be placed on the initial salary step of Rs. 94,400/- p.m., Academic Allowance of 91 % + Rs. 1,200/- of salary will be paid
- Salary and Academic Allowance will be paid according to the Commission Circular No. 02/2025 dated 01.04.2025.
- In addition to the above salary, cost of living allowance and other approved allowances will be paid to the selected candidate/s.
- The above rates are subject to change in accordance with government regulations.

Benefits:

- Selected candidates will contribute 10 % from their monthly salary to the Universities' Provident Fund, while the University will make a contribution of 15 % of their salary which 8 % will be credited to the Universities Pension Fund and 7 % to the Universities' Provident Fund. In addition, they will become contributors to the Employees' Trust Fund to which the University will contribute an amount equivalent to 3 % of the salary.
- Gratuity payment in accordance with the provisions of the Payment of Gratuity Act 12 of 1983.
- The holders of the posts of Senior Lecturer Grade II and above are eligible for one-year Sabbatical Leave with full pay or two years of leave without pay on completion of seven years of service. Further, those proceeding abroad during the Sabbatical Leave period are eligible to receive full air passage for self and spouse.

- Applicants currently in government service must forward their applications through the Heads of their Departments/ Institutions. In the event of an institutional delay, an **advance copy** must be submitted by the deadline to ensure eligibility.
- Print your downloaded application, sign it, and apply necessary rubber stamps. Send the hard copy and **Certified Copies of Certificates** via registered post to:
