Major Tasks and Responsibilities

The Project Director will be responsible for leading the project activities to achieve expected results within the given timeframe.

Qualifications: (1 or 2 below)

In accordance with Management Services Circular No. 02/2026 dated 28.03.2026, applicants must fulfil the following qualifications:

1. A Bachelor's Degree in the relevant field which is recognized by the UGC
AND
 - A Postgraduate Degree (Master's) in the field of Tourism and Hospitality Management, Project Management, Business Administration, Economics, or any other relevant degree / An Associated Membership / A similar professional qualification obtained from a recognized professional body in the relevant field**WITH**
 - At least 08 years of experience in the relevant field at a managerial level, out of which 04 years should be at a senior managerial level.**or**
2. Corporate / Fellow Membership obtained from a recognized professional body in the relevant field

 - At least 06 years of experience in the relevant field at a managerial level, out of which 03 years should be at a senior managerial level.

Salary: Rs 330,000 per month plus Government approved allowances

Post of Project Director shall be entitled to all allowances approved by the Government in accordance with the provisions of Management Services Circular No. 02/2026, dated 28.03.2026 issued by Management Services Department (MSD), the Ministry of Finance, Planning, and Economic Development.

Applicants should not be above 64 years of age as of the closing date of applications for the Post of Project Director.

Preference would be given to those who possess:

- Proven experience in tourism sector development, institutional strengthening, policy analysis, and institutional capacity building or strategic planning.
- Hands-on experience in working directly with national and provincial tourism planning and development.
- Strong understanding of tourism sector institutions, policy frameworks, and regulatory environments.
- Experience in implementation of foreign funded projects
- Competency in review of claims, preparation of responses and interpretation of contractual provisions etc.
- Knowledge of Microsoft Office packages and MS Project, or equivalent project management software, for Project Directors.
