The Board of Management invites applications from suitably qualified, dynamic and results-oriented individuals for the position of **Head of Finance & Supply Chain Management (SCM)**. The Head of Finance & Supply Chain Management will provide strategic and operational leadership to the Foundation's finance, procurement, inventory, logistics and supply-chain functions.

HEAD OF FINANCE & SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT (SCM)

Job Profile

The Head of Finance & Supply Chain Management will be responsible for providing strategic leadership and overall management of the Foundation's financial and supply-chain functions, ensuring alignment with its strategic and operational objectives. The role encompasses budgeting, financial planning and reporting, treasury and cash-flow management, auditing, procurement, inventory and logistics management. The position will also ensure compliance with applicable financial regulations, statutory requirements, governance standards and approved procurement procedures.

Key Responsibilities

- Review, maintain and improve existing financial, procurement and supply-chain policies, systems and internal controls, and develop and implement new policies and controls where necessary.
- Lead the annual budgeting process and monitor financial performance against approved budgets.
- Oversee accounting operations, financial reporting and treasury management and support internal and external audits.
- Ensure compliance with applicable financial regulations, taxation requirements, accounting standards, statutory obligations and governance requirements.
- Manage cash flow, financial planning, financial risk and the effective utilization of the Foundation's resources.
- Advise the Board and senior management on financial strategy, sustainability and cost optimization.
- Oversee procurement and supplier management, ensuring transparency, accountability, value for money and compliance with approved procurement procedures.
- Manage inventory, warehousing, logistics and supply-chain processes to ensure uninterrupted nationwide ambulance operations.
- Prepare and present accurate financial and non-financial reports to the Board and other relevant stakeholders.
- Lead and develop the finance and supply-chain teams, ensuring high levels of performance, integrity and accountability.
- Support emergency and crisis-management operations by ensuring the availability of critical financial, procurement, inventory and logistical resources.

Required Qualifications & Experience

- A Master's degree in Accounting or Finance, together with a minimum of Eight years of relevant managerial experience.
Or
- A Bachelor's degree in Accounting or Finance, together with a minimum of Twelve years of relevant managerial experience.
- Possession of a recognized professional qualification in accounting or finance, such as CA Sri Lanka, CIMA, ACCA or an equivalent qualification, will be a distinct advantage.

In addition, candidates must demonstrate:

- Proven senior-management experience in finance, budgeting, financial reporting, auditing, procurement and supply-chain operations.
- Strong knowledge of applicable accounting standards, taxation, statutory compliance, corporate governance and procurement procedures.
- Experience in managing finance and supply-chain operations within a large-scale organization.
- Exceptional analytical, communication, decision-making and problem-solving skills, with the ability to lead multidisciplinary teams and engage effectively with multiple stakeholders.
- Experience in a government, public-sector, healthcare or emergency-services organization will be a distinct advantage.

General Conditions

- Preference will be given to candidates with experience in large-scale or public-sector organizations.
- Willingness and ability to provide leadership on a 24/7 basis during emergencies and critical incidents.
- Applicants must demonstrate the highest standards of integrity, professionalism and ethical conduct.
- Applicants must be citizens of Sri Lanka.
- Age: 45 years and below.
- Applications must be submitted together with copies of certificates supporting educational and professional qualifications.
