POST OF LABORATORY ATTENDANT (ON CONTRACT)

Applications will be entertained from suitably qualified persons for the above post.

Qualifications:

1. Should have Passed the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) Credit (C) passes in not more than two sittings, and having obtained a proficiency certificate not below than the National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) Level 2 or 3 issued by a Technical or Vocational Training Institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the functions of a Laboratory Assistant.

OR

2. Should have passed G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) Credit (C) passes in not more than two sittings and having one (01) year of working experience in a relevant field with industrial skills.

Other Requirements

1. Must be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
2. Must be physically and mentally fit to perform the duties of the post satisfactorily.
3. Must be of good character.

Salary

Rs. 62,375/- per month, inclusive of allowances. (As per the University Council Decision)

The selected candidate will be a member of the Universities Provident Fund as well as the University Pension Scheme. He/ She will contribute 10% of his/her monthly salary to the Universities Provident Fund and at the same time the employer will make a total contribution of 15% of his/her salary of which 8% will be credited to the Universities Pension Fund and 7% to the Universities Provident Fund. Three percent (3%) of the salary will be contributed by the University to the Employees' Trust Fund.

Method of Recruitment

By a trade test and a structured interview.

Age

Applicants must be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age.

Application Procedure

Applicants serving in the University Grants Commission, a Higher Educational Institution, a Government Department, a State Corporation, or a Statutory Board must submit the application with a certification from the Head of their institution confirming that they can be released from service if selected for the post applied for.

Important Information

Failure to provide the required particulars, illegible or unclear information, receipt of the application after the closing date, failure to attach copies of the relevant certificates in support of qualifications and experience, or failure to satisfy any other requirement will result in rejection of the application. If a large number of applications is received, the Institute will adopt a suitable shortlisting procedure.

Applicants must verify the accuracy of all information before submitting the application online. Applications containing false or incomplete information will be rejected.

Once an application has been rejected, it will not be reconsidered for any reason.
