- (iii) Candidates of the Higher Educational Institutions/ Institutes, Government Departments, State Corporations and Statutory Boards should apply through the Heads of their respective institutions. Applications which are not forwarded through the respective Heads of Departments will be rejected.
- (iv) Applications received after the closing date, incomplete or not submitted on the format in the UCSC website will be rejected.
- (v) A non-refundable service fee of Rs. 1,500/- is payable. The fee shall be paid only through the payment methods available in the online application system:

- (vi) Only Candidates who have paid the prescribed non-refundable service fee within the stipulated period will be permitted to sit for the Aptitude Test. Eligibility based on the prescribed qualifications will be verified at the interview stage.
