Requirements and Qualifications:

- BSc. General Degree from a recognised university with at least 2 years of Industry experience or BSc. (Special) degree in one of these fields: Science, Food and Agriculture, Engineering, Management, Business Administration or equivalent
- Sound academic knowledge in related disciplines.
- Having work experience in the related field would be an added advantage
- Knowledge and a proficient user of computers and office software packages (MS Word, Excel, etc.) The employee must have a good command of the English language.
- Successful candidates should be self-starters, proactive and have good communication skills.
- Desire to innovate and advance experimental science.
- Team player who can work in a dynamic and multidisciplinary project team.
- Ability to organise and complete multiple tasks by establishing priorities.
- Thoroughly and methodically collects, verifies and records data, demonstrating attention to detail and identifying and correcting errors on own initiative.
- Demonstrates ability to quickly shift from one task to another to meet multiple support needs. Establishes, builds and maintains effective working relationships with staff to facilitate the provision of support

Duration of the appointment

Appointments will be made initially for three months and can be extended up to two years based on performance.

Remuneration:

Fixed monthly allowance of Rs. 48,000/- (inclusive of COL allowance) and will be entitled to EPF and ETF
